

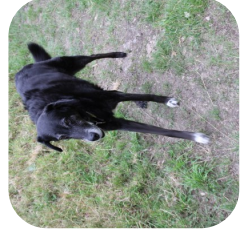


Dog Awareness Sharing our countryside

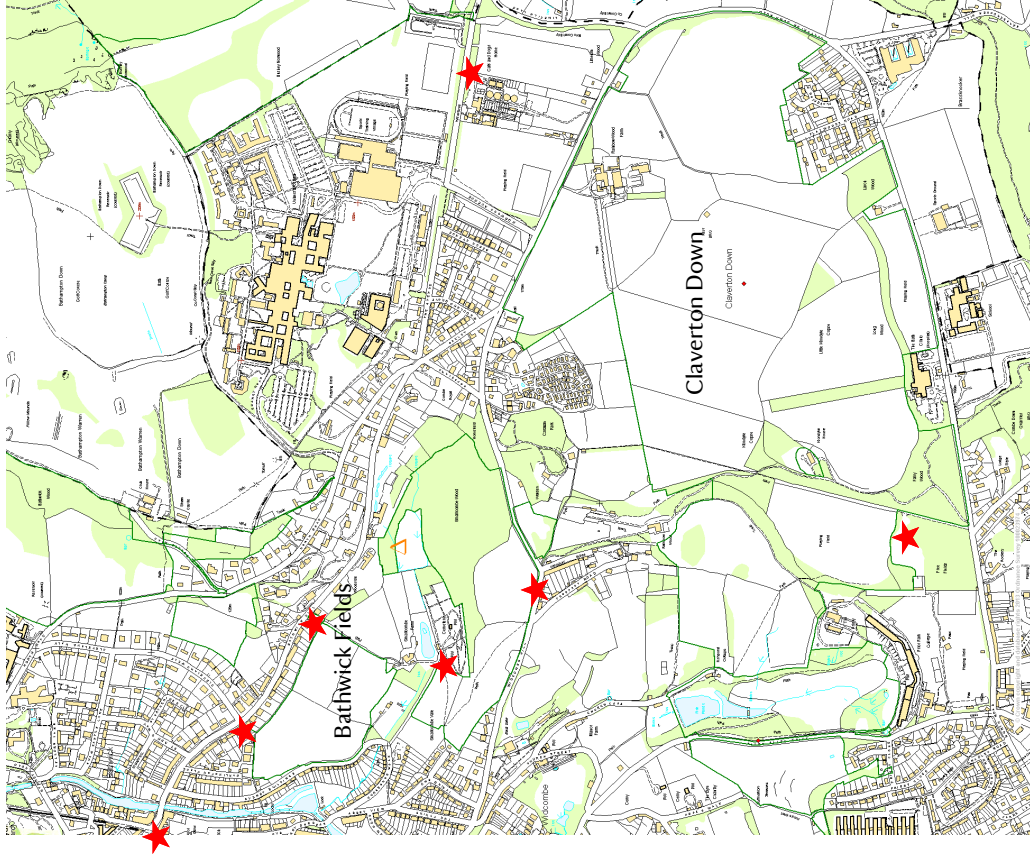
National Trust countryside is forever for everyone, and is shared by families and children, dog walkers, dog walkers, picnickers, runners and Skyline trail walkers

- Please bag and bin your dog waste - it is unsightly and smelly, and spreads infection and disease to livestock and people (Toxocariasis can be in dog waste and can cause illness and even blindness, particularly in children)
- You are welcome to use any general waste bin as well as dog bins
- In our beautiful countryside, please keep your dog under effective control
- Cows do graze in Bathwick fields in autumn for wildflower meadow conservation; signs will show which field is empty
- Cows are inquisitive and may come to investigate
- If cattle follow you - stay calm and walk quietly around the herd
- Try and avoid getting in-between cows and their calves
- Leave gates as you find them
