

How the University is operating a phased return and Covid testing after the winter break



Most of our students have now travelled away from Bath, following the successful roll out of lateral flow testing, which found a very small number of positive cases of Covid-19 as our [daily statistics](#) show. For those students who remain with us here in Bath, we are putting on Covid-secure [winter activities](#) and meals for household groups.

Looking ahead to 2021, we will be operating a staggered start after the winter break, following recent UK Government guidance.

The University's academic year means our undergraduate and Master's students have revision and online assessment in January, and the majority of our in-person learning and teaching starts in the first week of February for Semester 2.
